JOHN CAIRD (Book) is an author and director working in theatre, opera and musical theatre in London, New York, Tokyo and all around the world. Published works with MTI include Les Misérables (Schools Edition), (Children of Eden (with music by Stephen Schwartz) Jane Eyre (with music by Paul Gordon) and his own new version of Leonard Bernstein's Candide (originally performed at the National Theatre in London). Recent Productions include Tosca (Houston Grand Opera), Daddy Long Legs Off-Broadway), Love's Labour's Lost (Stratford Festival), McQueen (Haymarket Theatre, West End) Twelfth Night (Nissay Theatre, Tokyo) Tosca and Parsifal (Lyric Opera, Chicago), La Bohéme (San Francisco Opera), Gertrud (Royal Dramatic Theatre, Stockholm). Notable Engagements for the RSC include Over twenty productions including Midsummer Night's Dream, (RST) Romeo and Juliet (TOP) The Life and Adventures of Nicholas Nickleby (Aldwych Theatre and Broadway) Les Misérables (Barbican, Palace Theatre, Broadway and worldwide). Notable Engagements for the National Theatre include Hamlet, Humbleboy, Stanley, The Seagull and his own new version of Bernstein's Candide among many others. Elsewhere: Dance of Death, Merry Wives of Windsor, The Tempest and Romeo and Juliet (Royal Dramatic Theatre, Stockholm) Brief Encounter (Houston Grand Opera). He has won numerous awards including Olivier Awards for Nicholas Nickleby and Candide, and Tony Awards for Les Misérables and Nicholas Nickleby. PAUL GORDON (Music & Lyrics) Paul Gordon was nominated for a 2000 Tony Award for his score to Jane Eyre which ran at the La Jolla Playhouse in Summer of 1999 and opened on Broadway at the Brooks Atkinson Theater in December of 2000. Co-authored and directed by multiple Tony Award winning director John Caird, (Les Misérables, Nicholas Nickleby, Stanley) the musical was first presented at the Royal Alexandra Theater in Toronto in December of 1996. His previous musical, the contemporary pop opera Greetings From Venice Beach, in which he co-wrote the book and the music and lyrics, was first presented in Los Angeles in 1993. Currently he is collaborating with John Caird again on the musical Daddy-Long-Legs from the Jean Webster novel along with choreographer David Parsons. Paul has also written the music and lyrics for The Circle, with book by Shem Bitterman. Paul wrote and co-directed the independent film, Dirk and Betty, which premiered at the 1999 Hamptons Film Festival and stars Marisa Tomai, Eric Roberts and Jonathan Silverman. His current film, Folk Music, is scheduled to shoot this summer. Paul has written two number one songs. "Next Time I Fall" recorded by Peter Cetera and Amy Grant, and "Friends and Lovers", which went number one on both the pop and country charts. Some of the other artists he has written for or collaborated with, include Bette Midler, Quincy Jones, Alanis Morissette, Vonda Shepard, David Foster, Patti LaBelle, Eddie Rabbit, Juice Newton, James Ingram, The Pointer Sisters, Dionne Warwick, Olivia Newton-John, Eddie Money, Kenny Rogers, Smokey Robinson and Kenny G among many others. Paul has written songs for several films including "Stella", "Ghostbusters II", "Spacecamp", "Twilight Zone, The Movie", "Soul Man" and "The Principle". Paul is the recipient of nine A.S.C.A.P awards in both the pop and country field. His most recent award was received for the theme to Ally McBeal, co-written with Vonda Shepard.

MODERN HISTORY OF THE GLOVE



The Glove Theatre is a historic theatre located at 42 North Main Street, Gloversville, NY, built in 1914 presenting vaudeville shows, orchestral concerts and opera. During the theatre's heyday in the 1950's, this 800-seat theatre presented motion pictures and was the largest movie house in Fulton County.

In 1995, a plan arose to tear the theater down to become a parking lot, but community action stopped this from happening, and a dedicated board of volunteers have run the theater ever since.

This past summer, after an imposed hiatus due to the Covid-19 pandemic, The Glove presented Kampfire Stories, an original musical written by the youth of the greater Gloversville Area and directed/composed by Michael Maricondi.

In November, The Glove was privileged to present a production of Tennessee Williams' The Glass Menagerie, directed by Zachary Tomlinson and featuring professional actors from New York City. Menagerie... helped, also, to kick-off The Glove's new educational push, preparing a study guide program and inviting audiences to a talkback with the cast and creatives of this memorable production.

This past December, The Glove welcomed the Caroga Arts Ensemble for their Holiday Sweets & Suites concert, also marking the closing of the 2021 edition of their WinterFest.

The Glove Theatre is among the newly revitalized businesses in downtown Gloversville, and is planning a full season including plays, musicals, cabarets, concerts, readings, films, and other cultural events, has recently added new, staple programming to their 2022 calendar including The Whoopie Cushion, a burlesque-themed

variety talent show, and The Blackmon Film Series, which will present classic movies from the Golden Age of Cinema.

March 2022's presentation of Daddy Long Legs will mark the first of what The Glove hopes will be many collaborations with Master Class Performing Arts.

In April, The Glove will be presenting the April Fool's edition of The Whoopie Cushion, as well as an updated Blackmon Film Series, including Charade, His Girl Friday, Reefer Madness, and more. The Glove will also be welcoming the Fulton County Health Center to screen their movie, Someone You Love: The HPV Epidemic. In May, nationally-recognized stand-up comic, Tommy McLellan, will come to The Glove to present an evening of stand-up comedy.
